VACINATIONS :

HEALTH INSURANCE CARD (EHIC):

If you are visiting a European Union (EU) country it is recommended that you should apply for a free European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) and take it with you when you travel. You can obtain an application form from a main Post Office or you can apply online. Some travel insurance policies require you to obtain an EHIC card – please check before you travel

TRAVEL INSURANCE : It is your responsibility to ensure that all members of your travelling Group have an adequate and valid Travel Insurance policy – VALID FROM Your Date of BOOKING – This ensures you have Cancellation Cover in Place from the day you Book.

TRAVEL BY CAR - To travel with your car in Europe, you must carry:

Your photocard driving licence & Your passport Copies of your car insurance documents & Your vehicle's V5C logbook + UK stickers (if you're driving a car with GB plates)

Not having the correct documentation could land you a heavy fine, so make sure that you've got everything you need before you set off.
