



ADVICE For Valid Passports and Visas:

It is your responsibility to check and fulfil the passport, visa, health and immigration requirements applicable to your Travel itinerary. We can help and only provide general information about this. It is your responsibility to check requirements for your own specific circumstances with the relevant Embassies and/or Consulates and your own doctor as applicable.

Many Entry Requirements and Inoculation Requirements do change and you must check the latest position in good time before your Travel departure date.

Most countries now require passports to be valid for at least 6 months after your return date.

If your passport is in its final year, you should check with the Embassy of the country you are visiting.

FOR NEW ZEALAND - If you are not a New Zealand or Australian citizen, you may need to apply for a visa or a New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority (NZeTA) for traveling to or transiting New Zealand.
